- C. Freeport, Illinois residents only.
- D. Preference to active St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church members and their families (Not Required)
- E. Recipient must be a full or part-time student at Highland Community College
GPA of 2.00 on a 4.00 scale is required
- F. Financial Need:
