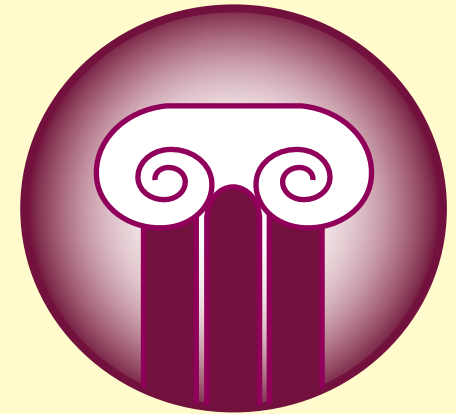
Cost

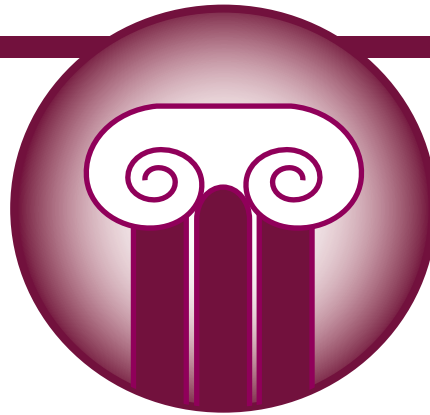
