- Pinned forum discussions, pin forum posts, allowing them to always be on the top, making them
 more visible to students. Tick the box to 'pin' the discussion to the top of the list.
- Permalink for discussions, click the Permalink in the lower right of the window which can be copied and pasted elsewhere, providing easy access to a post.
- Workshop enhancements, now you can specify the types of file you want student to submit or not. Students can also delete their own submissions.
- Tag course activities, tagging makes it simpler to find related content
- Easier section editing, now change section titles without leaving the page! Click on the pencil icon, rename the section, click the Edit menu to edit the description and other settings.
