Highland Collegiate Bowling - Competition Results - GLBC #1 - Minneapolis, MN

Last weekend was our first collegiate event of the year – the Great Lakes Bowling Conference Collegiate event in Brooklyn Park, MN (a suburb of Minneapolis). Highland, being a community college, always is the "young school" at our conference events, not to mention all the big Tier 1 events. We are only Freshman and Sophomores... but we compete as veterans.

The Great Lakes Bowling Conference is one of, of not the, largest collegiate bowling conferences in the nation. The colleges and universities in the conference consist of:

Men: UW-Whitewater, University of Iowa, Iowa State University, Western Illinois University, UW-Madison, MSOE, UW-Milwaukee, Winona University, UW-LaCrosse, University of Minnesota-Mankato, Viterbo University, UW-Oshkosh, UW-Platteville, UW-Green Bay, UW-Stout, UW-EauClaire, Rock Valley College, and Highland (the smallest school in the conference).

RESULTS:

The Highland Lady Cougars took to the lanes in Minnesota this weekend fielding a varsity team of six freshman and two sophomores and after Day #1 (6 traditional games of team bowling) were leading the tournament over Viterbo University by 250 pins. Sunday, the format of 16 Baker-style games, found the team struggling but still expanded their lead on Viterbo and took home the WIN in the GLBC 1st event of the season by an impressive 312 pins.
