# VEHICLE ACCESSIBILITY

Pretzel City Area Transit offers wheelchair access and transportation – we'll pick you up at your door and take you wherever you want to go.

#### RIDING BACK HOME

When we schedule your pick-up, we will also ask for you to schedule your return ride home. We do this because we operate on a first come, first served basis and when we are running full, callers without pre-scheduled rides (will-calls) could wait up to 2 hours. In order to reduce that waiting time, we encourage our riders to schedule the time for their rides home, even if it is just an educated guess.

To make an educated guess, if you think you will only need a half-hour at your doctor or to do a little shopping, we suggest you schedule the ride home for 45 minutes to an hour after the time we pick you up.
