Applications for this scholarship will be accepted from students who will be attending Highland Community College next fall. This scholarship award amount is \$2,000 and is for a full-time student enrolled at Highland Community College. (Half of the award will be issued in the fall, with the remaining half issued in the spring.)

Mrs. Ellen Stadermann was a Winslow resident who worked tirelessly over the years to improve her community. She served on the Stephenson County Board from 1994-1998 and was instrumental in getting the County's Civil War Monument listed on the National Register of Historic Places. For her efforts as a Cub and Boy Scout leader at unit, district, and council levels, she received the District Award of Merit "for outstanding service to youth." Mrs. Stadermann also volunteered for many years in the history room at the Freeport Public Library. She passed away in September 2017.

Priorities for selection:

- A. Recipient resides within the Highland Community College district.
- B. Student has a strong track record of community service, including leadership roles in some areas.
- C. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required.
