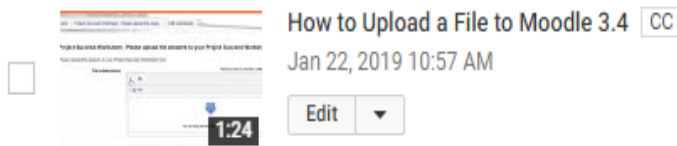


Automatically Creating Captioning for YouTube videos.

1. Log into your YouTube account.
2. Click on the circle icon with the first letter of your YouTube account, in the upper right hand corner.
3. Click on YouTube Studio beta. You should see your videos listed in the center of the webpage.
4. On the menu at the left, select Creator Studio Classic. On the right hand side of each video you will see an edit button with a pull down menu. Click the down arrow next to the edit button and select "Subtitles/CC". See graphic below.



5. If your video has Automatic Captions available, you will see a button with "English (Automatic)" on the right. Newly uploaded videos may need a few hours for the Automatic Captioning feature to appear. YouTube does not add punctuation to the captioning.
6. YouTube strongly suggests that you click the "English (Automatic)" button to review the captioning for accuracy. To edit your captions and add punctuation, click the edit button in the upper right button.
7. Click the blue save changes button in the upper right.
8. Congratulations! Your video now has Closed Captions available.
