Seminar subjects are designed to give program members pertinent information about leadership and on various important community topics *chosen from the input of each class*. Material will be presented in once-a-month, full day sessions from September 2019 to May 2020. By working closely with each other, Institute participants will broaden their understanding of community issues while enhancing their leadership skills.

Applications for the 2019-2020 program are due **July 1, 2019**.

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CANDIDATE SELECTION

- Because the program is seeking a broad cross section of leaders from within the community, class members selected, ideally, will have varied backgrounds, interests, viewpoints, and expertise among its participants.

 LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE is kept in confidence. Announcements of persons
 selected are made only after the applicants have been notified and have accepted
 their place in the program.
