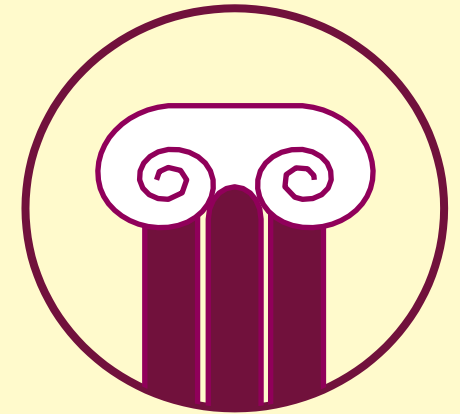
Cost
