### WHAT YOU MUST DO BEFORE FINANCIAL AID CAN BE AWARDED TO YOU

1. **If you and your spouse used the IRS Tax Retrieval process when completing your FAFSA and did not make any changes to that information, a 2018 tax transcript is not necessary.**
2. If you and your spouse did not use the IRS Tax Retrieval process or you made changes after the IRS Retrieval, contact the IRS at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov) or call 1-800-908-9946 to obtain a 2018 tax transcript.
3. **Complete all sections and sign the worksheet.**
4. Submit all required documents to the Office of Financial Aid.
5. If you did not file or are not required to file an IRS 1040, you and your spouse must affirm that you are not required to file an IRS 1040 and include a copy of 2018 W-2 Forms from all employers.
