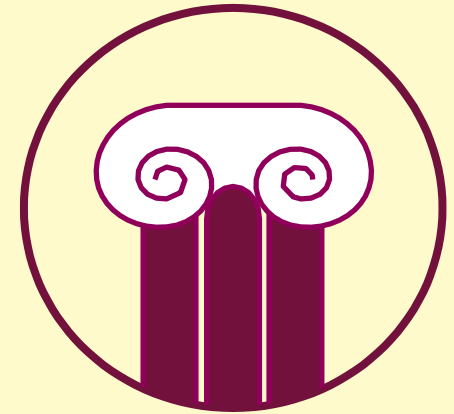
### Cost
