This scholarship consists of 2 - \$1,000 awards to be used for tuition or related expenses for a first-year, full-time student enrolling in a degree program at Highland Community College majoring in Business, Economics, Computer Science/IT, Mathematics, or Accounting. (The scholarship will be split with half of the award issued in the fall and the remaining portion issued in the spring after confirmation of standards of academic progress.) Students who have received this scholarship as freshmen are also **eligible to re-apply** for \$1,000 in their second year.

#### Criteria for selection:

- A. Preference to Student of Color historically underrepresented at HCC (e.g. Black, Hispanic, African American, Asian, American Indian or Alaskan Native, Asian or Pacific Islander, etc.)
- B. Financial need is a consideration
- C. A minimum GPA of 2.5 based on a 4.0 grade scale.
- D. Preference to students from northwest Illinois.

This award is not given for academics or highest GPA but for general accomplishments, and determination and likeliness to succeed.
