

## **International Admission Information**

An International student is a citizen of a country other than the United States who is authorized to remain in the United States for a temporary period of time, for educational purposes only as a non-immigrant (F1 or M-1 visa). He or she intends to return to his or her own country.

#### Admission

To be considered for admission to Highland Community College as an international student the following steps must be completed. Only after an admission has been granted will an I-20 be issued.

- 1. Complete, sign and submit the entire international student application packet.
- 2. Financial sponsor must complete and sign the Affidavit of Support. This affidavit must be signed and stamped by a bank official and must verify a current account balance with a minimum balance equal to one year of expenses in US dollars.
- 3. Submit authorized English translations and official certified copies of high school and college transcripts. The documents must indicate completion of the equivalent of secondary school.
- 4. For consideration into degree programs: Submit TOEFL test scores (with a minimum score of 500 on paper based, 173 on computer based, 61 on internet-based exams). Highland does not accept DuoLingo or any other language test at this time. Documentation of successful completion of another English language program in the United States may be considered on an individual basis.
- 5. Transfer students (F-1) must submit a copy of current I-20 form, transcripts and a letter from the current school showing dates of enrollment and eligibility to transfer.

All transcripts, letters and other admission materials become the property of Highland Community College. Late applications cannot be considered for admission. Completed applications will be reviewed on the above deadline and, if approved, Highland Community College will issue an I-20 form. The prospective student should follow instructions listed on the I-20 form and make an appointment at the nearest United States Embassy or Consulate to seek approval for an F-1 student visa.

#### **ESTIMATED COST OF ATTENDANCE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

The following is an estimate of the basic cost for an academic year (fall and spring semesters only) at Highland Community College. Remember, this is a minimum estimate. Students will need to plan for all additional expenses. The Board of Trustees reserves the right to change tuition and fees at any time.

Full time enrollment (12 credit hours or more) is required of all students on an F-1 visa (student visa) status.

The current out-of-country tuition and fee rate is \$292 per semester hour.

# Additional Information for Consideration (may not be applicable for all International Students) ROOM & BOARD

Highland Community College does not offer on-campus housing, nor does the college provide assistance in acquiring housing or room and board arrangements.

#### **CLOTHING & CLIMATE**

While living in Freeport, you will experience all four seasons. Winter days can be very cold (-18 degrees Celsius/ 0 degrees Fahrenheit or colder) and summer days are hot and humid. You will need clothing appropriate for all seasons.

#### STUDENT EMPLOYMENT

International students are <u>only eligible</u> to work part-time, on-campus jobs. Employment opportunities are <u>limited</u> and on-campus student employment is not guaranteed. F1 International students are <u>not</u> allowed to work outside of campus.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

Freeport Illinois does not have city wide transportation. There is a small transit system that passes can be purchased at the Highland Community College book store. There is limited taxi services as well.

#### **International Student Admission Frequently Asked Questions**

#### How long will it take to receive an I-20?

When an International Student Application is received in our office, it must be reviewed by the admissions team and documents checked for accuracy and eligibility. The admissions team will review only complete applications.

After the admissions team has reached a decision on your application you will be notified by email. It is important to understand that verification of foreign documents requires time and applicants need to plan ahead to schedule their admissions and start date accordingly.

If you are approved for admission, you will receive the Form I-20 and an acceptance letter from Highland Community College. If you are not approved you will be notified of the reason.

#### Will you e-mail me about my application?

#### Can I arrive early before my classes begin?

You are allowed to arrive up to 30 days before classes begin. It is imperative you arrive by the date listed on your I-20. You may not be allowed into the United States if arriving after the date listed.

# What do I need to do to transfer to Highland Community College from another U.S. college or University?

You must complete the application procedures by the stated deadline. In addition, you will need to submit a copy of your current I-20, be in good status with your current college or university, and have your current International Student Advisor complete the International Student Transfer form (available upon request). Be sure to include Official copies of all college and university transcripts as part of the application process.
