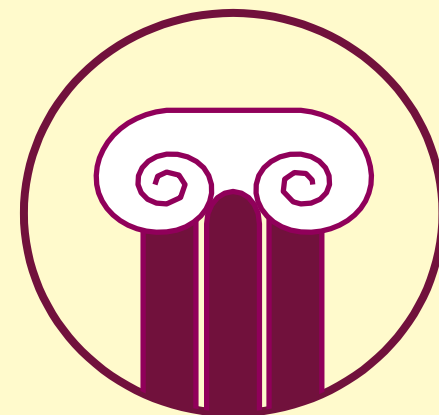
Cost

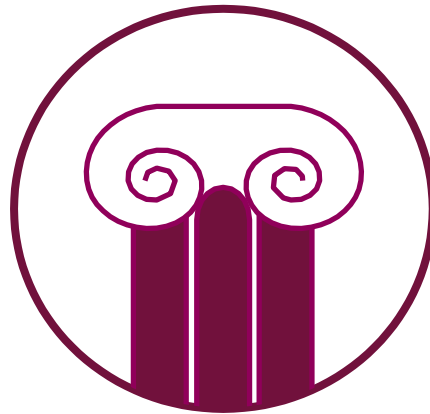
