

Veterans Benefits and Transition Act

As part of the Veterans Benefits and Transition Act of 2018 any students using Chapter 33 Post 9/11 GI Bill[®], Chapter 35, or Chapter 31 Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment will not be penalized by holds or late fees (for up to 90 days) or be required to borrow additional funds while payment for the students covered balance is pending receipt by the institution.

Students must submit documentation of eligibility for VA Benefits to the school prior to the final payment deadline date for the term. Failure to do so, will result in the student not being protected under this Act and thus a late payment fee may be applied. Furthermore, students utilizing VA Benefits must submit a signed form requesting to use such entitlement.

Acceptable documentation of eligibility includes:

- Certificate of Eligibility for entitlement to educational assistance under Chapters 33 or 31, or
- A “Statement of Benefits” obtained from the Department of Veterans Affairs’ website – www.va.gov, or
- A VA Form 28-1905 for Chapter 31 authorization

Students are responsible to cover any unmet portion of tuition payments as a result of qualifying for less than 100% and will be subject to late fees if not paid before the school’s deadline date for the term. Furthermore, the school may use standard collection policies for amounts not met.
