3. **Complete all sections and sign the worksheet** – you and at least one parent must sign the worksheet.
4. Submit all required documents to the Office of Financial Aid.
5. If you or your parents did not file or are not required to file an IRS 1040, you and your parents must affirm that you are not required to file an IRS 1040 and include a copy of 2022 W-2 Forms from all employers.
