INFORMATION ABOUT WITHDRAWING FROM CLASS(ES) AND RETURN OF TITLE IV FUNDS
If you wish to withdraw from a class or classes, you must complete that process at the Office of Admissions and Records. Changes in enrollment will likely affect the amount of your financial aid award. A reduction in your award could result in you owing on your student account. If you are receiving Federal Pell or SEOG Grant or Stafford Loan, you are subject to the Return of Title IV Funds Policy. This means that if you withdraw from all or some of your courses at HCC, you may be required to repay a percentage of financial aid that has already been awarded. Completion of a module course (8 or 5 week course) does not prevent a student from being subject to the Return of Title IV calculation.
For example: A student registers for 16 weeks of classes in the fall semester, but withdraws before the 16 week term is over. Federal regulations require that the student's aid is prorated based on the portion of the 16 weeks he/she attended. The student may now owe tuition/fee charges to the college, since the award has been reduced.
